

DOG PARK RULES

1. Your new MCAS Yuma dog park is designated for dogs, their handlers and those who accompany them. No other use is allowed.
2. Dogs must be current with all vaccinations (rabies and yearly 4-in-1s), and dog owners/handlers may be required to provide documentation.
3. Dogs must wear a Station Identification tag at all times (issued at PMO Animal Control).
4. Puppies less than four months of age and female dogs in heat are prohibited.
5. Dogs must be on a leash in all common areas on the Air Station until they are secured in the double-gated transition area, at which time the leash should be removed before entering the unleashed area.
6. Be patient when entering and exiting the park. Do not enter the double-gated transition area if there is someone already present. This eliminates the possibility of both gates being open at the same time.
7. Choke, prong and spike collars are strictly prohibited. If you use these types of collars remove them before entering the park and ensure the dog's ID tag is on an acceptable collar or harness.
8. Dog handlers must keep their leash in hand at all times.
9. All off leash dogs must be under voice control of their handlers. If you cannot control your dog off leash, keep them leashed at all times.
10. Aggressive or disruptive dogs must be removed from the off leash area at the first sign of aggression and may not return until socialization measures have been undertaken.
11. Do not bring dog food into the park.
12. Food and drink in glass containers are prohibited.
13. The owner/handler must clean up dog feces immediately and fill all holes dug by your pet. Also, please help control "orphan poop." Seal the waste in the provided plastic bags before disposal into designated receptacles.
14. Children under the age of 16 are not permitted unless accompanied by an adult.
15. Failure to abide by park rules may result in loss of privileges, and owners may be ticketed.

Keeping the Dog Park a safe, positive environment for exercising your dogs is our goal. You can help by maintaining visual contact and control of your pets and by keeping the park perfectly clean.

Please remember! Look around before leaving the park to ensure there is not trash, cigarette butts or feces left behind.
