### Fuel Truck Trailer Struck by Train

**MARINE CORPS AIR STATION YUMA, Ariz. (April 6, 2015)** – A military fuel truck trailer was struck by a supply train at approximately 11:45 a.m. on highway 89, 65 miles east of MCAS Yuma, Monday. There are no known deaths or injuries at this time.

The military fuel truck was in route to a vehicle and aircraft refueling point while conducting training for Weapons and Tactics Instructor Course (WTI).

The train impacted the trailer portion of the truck, causing the cargo of approximately 4,500 gallons of fuel to catch fire. The cause of the incident is under investigation.
