Subj: HEALTH CARE CONSUMERS' COUNCIL

1. Purpose. To establish a Health Care Consumers' Council.
2. Background. The council provides a regularly scheduled meeting for information that will contribute to a better understanding of mutual problems. Medical representatives will have the opportunity to explain policies, practices, problems, changes in regulations, services available, etc. Likewise, consumer representatives will have an opportunity to introduce for discussion items related to the delivery of health care.
3. Information. The council shall be chaired by the Executive Officer, Marine Corps Air Station. The council is comprised of the following members:

    - (8) Health Benefits Advisor

    - (10) Representatives from any other service from which agenda items will be discussed.

4. Action

(a) Meetings of the council will be held at least quarterly, normally on the third Wednesday of February, May, August and November. Invitations will be sent to both designated and invited membership at least three weeks prior to each meeting.

(b) Minutes of the meetings shall be prepared by the Officer-in-Charge, Branch Medical Clinic for the Chairman's signature. A file of all minutes of meetings and responses thereto shall be retained for review by the Inspector General (Medical).

5. Concurrence. The Commanding Officers of MAWTS-1, MAG-13, MWSS-371, MACS-1, VMFT-401, and CSSD-16 concur in and make this Directive applicable to their respective Commands.
