- 4. Prerequisites. Service members must meet the following requirements.
 - a. Grade of Lance Corporal or their service's most senior non-NCO.
 - b. Current passing Marine Corps physical and combat fitness test scores.
 - c. Meets current height, weight, and body fat standards.
 - d. Completion of command screening checklist
 - e. The Marine must be in a full duty status
- 5. Nominations. The nominations will be submitted by August 11 and are only accepted by the unit's S-3. If commands do not submit their nominations by the given date, then those commands may lose the last seats. Units may submit more service members than the given allocation; these Marines will be on standby status and will be given priority over walk-ons. Nominations will be submitted to the Corporal's Course Staff Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge Office via email to Randolf.Revert@usmc.mil no later than the close of business August 12, 2014.

- 6. <u>Billeting</u>. Billeting will not be provided or required for students attending Lance Corporals Seminar. Student's billeting arrangements should remain the same as with their parent commands. Otherwise, they will be returned to their units
- 7. Minimum Required Gear. Service member's will be required to have the following items.

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 - a. Note pad or book.
 - b. Ink pen.
 - c. Armed forces Identification Card.
 - d. Command Screening Checklist.
- 8. Reporting Procedures. Students will report to the course building at the Marksman Training Unit facility building 1248 at 0630 on the convening date of the course. The reporting uniform will be seasonal MARPAT.
- 9. Appointments and Duty. Students attending this course MUST NOT have scheduled appointments or duty assignments. Service members will not be excused from attending PT and training due to childcare issues. Service members will need to make accommodations regarding child care before attending the course.
- 10. <u>Graduation</u>. Graduation will be held at the Marksmen Training Unit building 1248 15 August the last day of the course at 1700. Uniform for students will be the MARPAT.
