Master Gunnery Sergeant (MGySgt) Steven M. Baduske is currently the Provost Sergeant, Provost Marshal's Office, Marine Corps Air Station, Yuma AZ.

MGySgt Baduske enlisted in the Marine Corps on 12 January 2004 and underwent Marine Corps Recruit Training at Parris Island, South Carolina. Upon graduation, he was assigned to Marine Combat Training at Camp Geiger, NC, and Military Police School at Ft. Leonard Wood, Missouri.

In September 2004, LCpl Baduske reported to MCAS Cherry Point PMO. During this tour, he fulfilled duties as a Patrol Supervisor, Desk Sergeant, Accident Investigator, Special Reaction Team Member, and Physical Security Specialist. During this tour, Cpl Baduske was promoted to the rank of Corporal. While here, Cpl Baduske was selected to become an Individual Augment for I MEF Forward and deployed to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom from March 2006 to January 2007. While in Iraq, Cpl Baduske served as the Anti-Terrorism Force Protection NCO for the G-3. Upon completion of his deployment, Cpl Baduske returned to MCAS Cherry Point to serve as a Special Reaction Team Member and was promoted to the rank of Sergeant.

In February 2009, Sergeant Baduske was transferred to the Chemical Biological Incident Response Force, Indian Head, MD, and assigned as the Battalion Training NCO and Anti-Terrorism Force Protection NCO. During this tour, Sgt Baduske was meritoriously promoted to the rank of Staff Sergeant.

In July 2012 he was transferred to the PMO, MCAS Iwakuni, Japan. During this tour, he filled the billet of a Watch Commander and Physical Security Chief. As the Physical Security Chief, he was responsible for overseeing all new Defense Policy Review Initiative construction projects aboard the air station.

In June of 2015, SSgt Baduske volunteered for Marine Security Guard duty and attended the Detachment Commander Course in Quantico, VA. After graduation, SSgt Baduske was assigned as the Detachment Commander for the Embassy Sofia, Bulgaria. During this tour, SSgt Baduske was promoted to the rank of Gunnery Sergeant and was hand-selected to become an Instructor Advisor at the Marine Corps Embassy Security Guard School. Upon completion of his tour on MSG duty, GySgt Baduske received orders to 1st Law Enforcement Battalion, Camp Pendleton, CA. During this tour, he served as a Platoon Sergeant for Bravo Company and as H&S Company Gunnery Sergeant. During this assignment, he deployed with the 11th Marine Expeditionary Unit, where he served as the Anti-Terrorism Force Protection Chief.

He was then transferred in December 2021 to 1st Marine Logistics Group, I MEF, Camp Pendleton, CA. There he was assigned as the Physical Security, Anti-Terrorism Force Protection, and OPSEC coordinator for the group. During his tour, GySgt Baduske was promoted to his current rank of Master Sergeant.

In July 2022, MSgt Baduske received orders to MCAS Yuma where he was assigned the billet of Operations Chief. In April 2024, Master Gunnery Sergeant Baduske was promoted to his current rank and assigned his current billet as the Provost Sergeant, Provost Marshal's Office, MCAS Yuma, Arizona.

MGySgt Baduske's decorations include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal 4th award, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal 4th award, and the Humanitarian Service Medal.
