
COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

It is highly contagious, spreading from person to person.

In just a few months, it has infected millions of people worldwide.

COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

How to protect yourself and others

Keep physical distance of at least 6 feet.

Practice frequent hand washing for 20 seconds and/or use hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.

Frequently sanitize work surfaces and tools.

Cover coughs and sneezes and wear a face mask.

Avoid touching the eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands.

COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

Safe Guards while in Military Training Areas

Keep your physical distance and limit contact with individuals not assigned to your unit or training areas. Wear a mask when needed.

Use **CAUTION** when interacting with individuals from the following support services:

Government Civilian Employees (i.e. Range Training, Base Safety, Environmental, etc.).

Government Contract and Civilian Contract Employees (i.e. URS, KBR, SWTTR and Waste Disposal, Sanitation, ICE Services, etc.).
