

## AMOS 8056 “HM/HW Marine” Requirements

### A. TRAINING

#### 1. Take the Online training

“USMC - Introduction to Hazardous Material and Hazardous Waste” Code MCIEIHM01A. Find this training at MarineNet webpage: <https://www.marinenet.usmc.mil>

#### 2. Attend the following Classroom training (Choose a or b)

- a. MCAS Yuma 24 Hour “Environmental Compliance Management Course (ECMC)”. This course complies with Marine Corps specific requirements for First Responders at the Operations Level IAW 29 CFR 1910.120 (Q). It’s offered quarterly at building 321.
